Recommended Items to Avoid


SEVERE WEATHER ALERT-Unseasonably cold temperatures and heavy rains continue to affect many crops grown in California and Yuma AZ. Quality and availability of products impacted include **Strawberries, Iceberg, Romaine, Celery, Cauliflower, Broccoli** and **Brussels Sprouts**.


 **STRAWBERRIES** – Poor growing conditions (cold and rain) in California continue to affect quality throughout the market. Pricing is stable, but quality remains fair to poor. Short shelf life, white shoulders and decay are reported.

 **Broccoli** – Supplies of Broccoli Crowns are light, and pricing is 10-15% higher than normal, with good quality reported. Consider using Florets for optimal value.


 **Lettuce:** and to a lesser degree **Romaine** and **Leaf Lettuce**, is fair at best. Puffiness, ribbing and short shelf life are all quality issues, and pricing is up to 20% higher than normal. Consider using **Romaine Hearts** or **pre-cut product** for best overall value.


 **CELERY** – Pricing remains very high on both bulk and pre-cut Celery, also due light supplies from the cold, wet conditions in Yuma. Quality is fair to good.

 **CAULIFLOWER** – Supplies of **Heads** and **Florets** are extremely tight. Pricing remains 15% higher than normal, quality is fair, and orders may be shorted or substituted. Avoid use where possible.

 **SOFT VEGETABLES** – **Bell Peppers** and **Cucumbers** are in a growing gap in Florida and Mexico. Pricing is much higher than normal, up to 40% more expensive, and quality is fair. **Choice Grade Green Bells** and **Select Grade Cucumbers** are the best values.


MARKET OPPORTUNITIES

MIXED BERRIES – Blackberries and Blueberries are very good quality and pricing. 

SPECIALTY POTATOES- Quality is very good on all Colored, Fingerling and Yukon Potato varieties. 

GRAPES – Quality and pricing of Red and Green Grapes are very nice. 

CALIFORNIA NAVEL ORANGES- Quality is very nice and pricing is good on 88 CT and larger sizes of Fancy- and Choice-grade Navels. 

CHILI PEPPERS – Anaheim, Serrano and Pasilla Peppers are all very good quality.

A Peek at Peak Seasons

Late Winter Greens – Endive, Chicory and Frisee are all available. All are great cold-weather menu favorites!

Swiss Chard – Great quality on Green, Red and Rainbow Chard out of California and Mexico.

Grapefruit – Texas and Florida are at peak harvest on Ruby Reds.

Pineapples – Quality is very good out of Central America, particularly, Costa Rica, on all sizes and varieties.

Weather Update

California: Wind, rain and cooler temperatures persist in most growing regions.

Yuma, AZ: Cold temperatures, overnight icing and strong winds expected.

Mexico: Seasonal temperatures and precipitation.

Florida: Cooler than normal temperatures and seasonal precipitation.

 AVOCADO	Quality and pricing are good
 BELL PEPPERS	Quality is fair, pricing is very high, particularly Red and Yellow
 BERRIES (BLACKBERRIES)	Quality and pricing are good
 BERRIES (BLUEBERRIES)	Quality and pricing are good

 BERRIES (STRAWBERRIES)	Quality is poor, pricing may be higher
